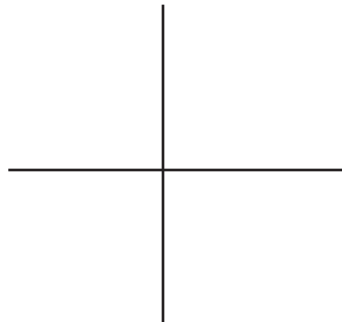
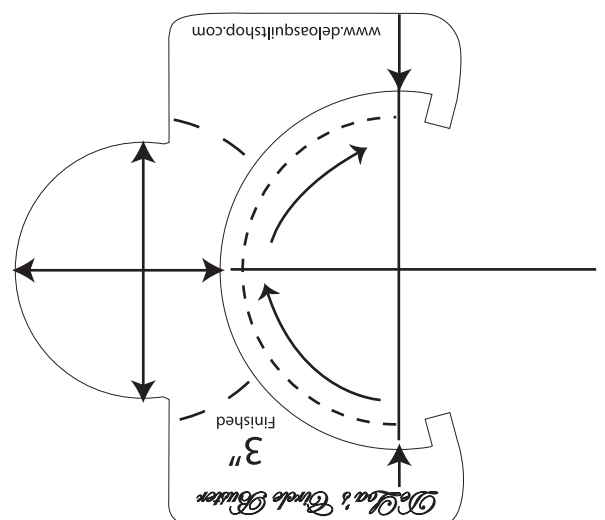
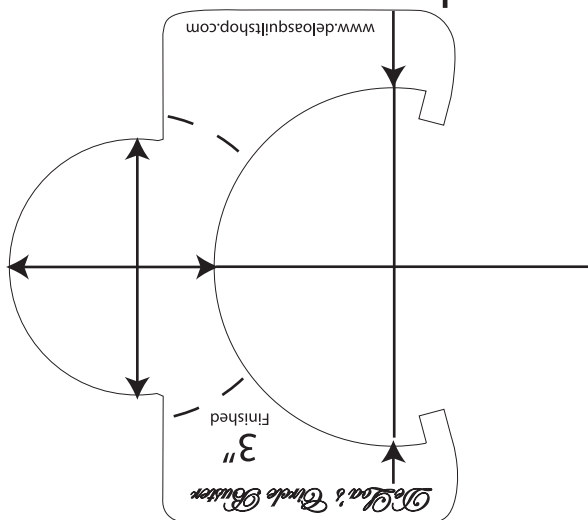


DeLoa's Circle Buster Instructions

1. It is easiest to use a marked cross hair when creating circles. This ensures a centered and complete circle. Mark the cross hairs with any marking tool that you like to use.



2. Place the ruler onto the fabric, matching the cross hairs on the ruler to those that you have marked on the quilt. Do the Inner circle first when possible.



3. Sew the first half of the circle.
Stop and keep the needle down.

4. Flip the ruler around. Line up the Cross hairs and the etched stitch lines. Sew the other half of the circle using the Outer circle.
